

## **FUNDAMENTALS OF HORSEMANSHIP**

STUDENTS: Classes may start from the BARN or the PICNIC TABLE (see directions below). CHECK WITH LYNN CARR (310.454.0343) PRIOR TO YOUR FIRST CLASS FOR INSTRUCTIONS ON WHICH AREA WILL BE YOUR MEETING LOCATION.



## TO SADDLEROCK RANCH (maps not to scale)

**FROM THE VENTURA FWY** Exit Kanan Road and travel south for approximately 7 miles to Mulholland HWY (you will pass through two tunnels before reaching Mulholland); turn RIGHT on Mulholland.

**FROM PACIFIC COAST HWY** Turn north on Kanan Dume Road and proceed approximately 6.5 miles to Mulholland HWY (at mile 5, you will pass through a tunnel); turn LEFT on Mulholland.


MAIN RANCH ENTRANCE / BARN The main entrance to the ranch is located 0.7 mi from the intersection of Kanan and Mulholland on the north side of Mulholland (look for the wine barrel near the highway). You will see a call box to open the private gate. To open the gate to enter the ranch press: \*8278. Take the road to the top of the hill and veer right, following the road toward the stables. OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT. Park in the parking lot. Walk up the hill on the road to the Big Barn (on the left). The office is the first door on the last row of the Barn.

To open the gate to leave the ranch press: \*827800.

**PICNIC TABLE ENTRANCE** This entrance is on Mulholland highway, about 0.9 mi from the intersection of Kanan and Mulholland. Pass the main entrance and continue about 0.2 mi. As the road bends to the right, look for an unpaved driveway on the RIGHT – enter here. Landmarks: A wine tasting area on the left, a telephone pole on the right – the driveway is across from the end of the fence and just before the telephone pole.

Drive about 50 yards to the open parking area under the trees. The *Fundamentals of Horsemanship* class meets at the round picnic table near the screened enclosure.

WHAT TO WEAR Jeans or comfortable trousers (no shorts or bell bottoms). PLEASE WEAR A BELT OR TROUSERS/JEANS WITH BELT LOOPS. This is necessary to attach our radios securely to each rider. Wear shoes with smooth soles. This can be tennis shoes (if soles are smooth), cowboy boots, paddock boots, or leather-soled shoes. No hiking boots or sport shoes with lug soles. Dress for the weather but avoid very loose fitting jackets or sweaters. Safety helmets will be provided.



Please do not bring children or guests with you. SADDLEROCK RANCH is a private residence as well as a working vineyard and horse boarding facility. Obey the 5 MPH posted speed limit on the narrow ranch roads. No dogs allowed. SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ON RANCH PROPERTY.
